7th grade students are invited to apply to enter the Academic Challenge Program at Delaware Technical and Community College

Program Description:

- The Academic Challenge Program is a five-year program of accelerated instruction in English and/or mathematics beginning in eighth grade
- Level 1-3 (8th through 10th grade) students complete the high school curriculum
- Level 4 & 5 (11th and 12th grade) students take DTCC college courses in English and math
- Students can earn a total of 12 English and/ or 15 mathematics credits, transferrable to most colleges and universities
- Students in Levels 1-3 are bused by the home school to DTCC on Tuesdays to take their classes
- Students in Levels 4 & 5 take college courses whenever they are scheduled (students choose morning, afternoon, or evening, depending on offerings) and provide their own transportation to DTCC

Eligibility Requirements:

- Student eligibility is determined by a formula combining an average of the student's first three marking period grades from 7th grade in the subject area, 6th grade subject area Smarter Balanced test scores, an Evaluation of Student Skills by teachers in the subject area, and SAT, PSAT 10, or PSAT 8/9 scores in the subject area. The SAT, PSAT 10, or PSAT 8/9 are not required but can be used by students to earn additional points towards qualification
- Students must earn a combined minimum of 50 total points from grade average, Smarter
 Balanced test scores, teacher recommendations, and SAT/PSAT/PSAT 8/9 scores to qualify

2018-2019 Selection Process:

- The Selection Process will take place February-April 2019. Information on the Selection Process
 will be sent home by the counselor at the beginning of February, and students will be notified of
 qualification in April.
- Students will be notified by the counselor in the Fall of 2018 about opportunities to take the PSAT 8/9 during the 2018-2019 school year.
